CSSL President's Column



As you may have read in my first message to you as the President of Computer Society of Sri Lanka (CSSL), I outlined our vision for CSSL and our industry.

Today, I wish to give you a quick snapshot of what we have been doing in the first two months in office as the new Executive Council.

Immediately after the AGM, I and my predecessor Dr Dayan Rajapakse attended ExCo meeting of the South East Asian Computer Confederation (SEARCC), where we were able to discuss regional and international activities that will happen in Sri Lanka in 2017. We also met with a number of Australian and other international ICT leaders and we are now in discussions with them on various initiatives.

The CSSL Executive Council traditionally has an offsite workshop to deliberate the plans for the new year and this happened in January.

We also partnered with International Conference in Technology Management 2016, which was organized by Department of Management of Technology, University of Moratuwa.

We also supported a Hackathon to give a hand to the next generation of ICT innovators. Games Lab, an IT startup, conducted this hackathon for students from both local and

private Universities. Out of the 45 application they had got, four teams were chosen to compete during the hackathon on 14th of January from 11.30 AM to 6.30PM. The hackathon named as HackIT 2K17 was not only a competition but also an event that introduced many cyber security and networking professionals to those present at the event.

We continued to take part in policy matters by making representations related to Free Trade Agreements with India and other countries. CSSL maintains its clear stance that any agreement should be signed in a way that it does not disadvantage our professionals and people of this country while having proper controls in place.

We launched a major initiative in January to broaden our student membership. With this, now we are working with many government and private sector universities to bring on board all their students. Currently enrolling of bulk student memberships are planned with ESOF, SLIT and Sabaragamuwa University. We are engaged in discussion with University of Moratuwa and University of Jayawardenapura. If you are from an academic institution, please get in touch with us to discuss the ways of making your students, student members of the ICT professional association, the CSSL. Having all our ICT students as our student members

is important, so that they progress into CSSL professional membership later. I hope this important strategic move will have a long lasting impact on CSSL's strength.

In 2017, National IT Conference (NITC) of Sri Lanka will be held in partnership with SEARCC Conference 2017 and will be held in Colombo in September. SEARCC (South East Asian Regional Computer Confederation - <http://www.searcc.org>) organises an annual conference every year in a selected country in the region, and in 2017, its Sri Lanka's opportunity. The event will run in parallel to IFIP General Assembly.

International Federation for Information Processing (IFIP) is the leading multinational organization in ICT which is recognized by United Nations and other world bodies. IFIP has the representation of ICT Societies from 56 countries/regions, covering five continents with a total membership of over half a million. It links more than 3500 scientists from Academia & Industry. (<http://ifip.org>)

The General Assembly requires IFIP General Assembly members to come to Sri Lanka and it is expected that about 60+ foreign individuals will come for the meeting. SEARCC Conference, SEARCC Executive Committee Meeting and associated meetings will bring over 20 top notch IT leaders from the South East Asian Region including Australia, Papua New Gunia, Malaysia, India and Taiwan.

IFIP General Assembly, SEARCC Conference and National IT Conference has created a unique International, Regional and National blend.

An event of this magnitude with such broad international participation has not occurred in Sri Lanka in relation to the ICT sector. So, we truly believe that this is a golden opportunity for our ICT industry and the country at large. We look forward to your support in terms of speaking at the conference, submitting papers, organizing committee volunteering and sponsorships to make Sri Lanka proud during this historic event.
